

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1973

**DIRECTION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY
COMMISSION FOR SCOTLAND 2018**

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 15(3) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 (the 1973 Act) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby direct the Local Government Boundary Commission for Scotland (the Commission) not to conduct any review of any local government area or areas or parts thereof under section 14(2) of the 1973 Act during the period beginning on 1 October 2018 and ending on 30 September 2023, other than a review of boundary issues between two or more local authority areas that would potentially directly affect not more than 500 electors. This Direction is without prejudice to the power of the Scottish Ministers under section 15(2) of the 1973 Act to direct the Commission to conduct a review of any one or more local authority areas or parts thereof.
